New Business:

Football—New Pressbox. It was moved by Lori Smith and seconded by Janet Schetzle to give \$500 plus the cost of the sign towards the purchase of a new pressbox at the football field. Motion passed. (Note: Renae Bafus abstained from voting) There have been other coporate sponsors that have contributed the same amount: Inland Cellular, Coldwell Bankers, Dismores.. The football team is going to ask some others to contribute.

Appreciation Event: The date for the appreciation event was set for Saturday, November 30, 2013 during the quad basketball game with Deary. Time will be 2:00 to 5:30. We will be serving cake during the games. Invitations will be sent out with the Thank yous to all Trojan Boosters.

Booster Bounce: The date for the Booster Bounce 2014 was set for the weekend of March 15-16, 2014.

Old Business:

Membership Drive Update: Board members are going to continue to call their list of people. The final cut-off date to pay fees and keep signs up is set for September 30, 2013. We have approximately 10 new members and have raised close to \$4000.

June Camp—In June the Trojan Boosters agreed via email to assist a student-athlete with the expense of going to Football camp. The Boosters will reimburse Renae Bafus the \$150.
